Summer User Water Turn on Dates: Monday, May 12 & Tuesday, May 13, 2025



Your water will **NOT** be turned on if your 2025 annual amount or any other outstanding utility charges have not been **paid by May 5, 2025.** **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

- ◆ Payments received after this date will be required to pay a \$100.00 turn on fee and will have to arrange an alternate turn on date with the CRPUB office.
(Alternate dates may be 3 to 5 days after the regular scheduled turn on date.)

- This bill covers service charges for the current summer user year. Your actual water usage will be billed out in December.
- **Early/Late Turn On/Off Requests:** Must be submitted one week (7 days) in advance along with the Early/Late Turn On/Off fee of \$100.00. No short notice requests will be considered. Please plan ahead.
- The Water Operator/Maintenance personnel are unable to accept change requests from individual water subscribers, all changes such as early/late turn on/off requests must be made through the CRPUB office.

Outstanding Accounts: Accounts with arrears that are not paid by December 31, 2025 will have any arrears added to the taxes and a \$50.00 fee will be added to the Utility Account. (Policy No. 2017-03)
